



Terry Lynch Jaycee Community Service Scholarship

The Virginia Jaycees provide up to five (5) \$1,000 scholarships to deserving individuals throughout the Commonwealth each year. The awarding of these scholarships is handled through a panel of judges comprised of individuals from around the Commonwealth of Virginia. Scholarship recipients will be selected by June 15 and will be notified by letter.

RULES:

- 1. The completed application must be submitted with the following attachments (All other attachments will be disregarded; thus disqualifying the application if these attachments are not submitted):*
 - Most recent federal tax return;*
 - Most recent official high school or college transcript;*
- 2. Final selection of recipients is based on the following criteria:*
 - Potential for academic success;*
 - Financial need;*
 - Leadership qualities;*
 - Community Involvement.*
- 3. This application must be postmarked and submitted directly to The Virginia Jaycees by May 15, 2007.*

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

1. The scholarship may be used at any college or university of the recipient' choice, including institutions of learning beyond the continental limits of the United States.
2. The scholarship recipient must submit a certificate of admission or a letter of acceptance from the college or university to the Executive Vice President of the Virginia Jaycees when he/she wishes to make use of the scholarship.
3. The scholarship entitles the recipient to receive credit for tuition, books, laboratory fees or other academic costs. Personal allowances or expense monies to the recipient of the scholarship are not permitted.
4. The scholarship check will be sent directly to the institution involved. The institution will credit the recipient's account in the amount of the scholarship for the duration of the recipient's enrollment or until expended by the recipient.
5. In the event that the recipient leaves the institution for any reason and funds from this scholarship remain as a credit to his/her account, the institution involved shall return the balance of the scholarship to The Virginia Jaycees.
6. Should the recipient leave an institution entered under the scholarship to enter the armed forces, or to continue in graduate education at another institution, any balance of this scholarship remaining to his or her credit, shall be available at the institution of his or her choice, subject to these terms and conditions.
7. The institution involved is requested to forward to the Executive Vice President of the Virginia Jaycees a transcript of the recipient's grades at the end of each semester or quarter in which the scholarship funds were used.
